MESSAGE FROM EMILY

Happy New Year!



A huge welcome back and I hope you have had a wonderful festive break. What an exceptionally busy and exciting time last half term was! We had the fireworks, the Christmas Fair (more on those below), the wonderful Christmas shopping event for the children; and the children's Christmas parties. The children also designed their own Christmas cards which raised a fabulous **£542**. It is with the money raised by HISNA that allow the children's Christmas parties at the school to happen, so huge thank you to everyone that organised these events (specifically Anna Juniper, Daisy Mason and Caroline Turner); and to all the people that volunteered to help. The parent/carer and teacher community at Hampton Infants is a very special one, and the children are so lucky to have this at their school.



So far we have raised a staggering **£12,800** since September! The money raised by HISNA has contributed 60% of the total cost of the new year 1 & 2 playground equipment which should be ready for its grand opening after the Easter break.

The new equipment includes a climbing frame, floor games, a bowling alley and much more. We have also been able to put a massive **£15,000** towards phase 2 of the playground equipment for the Nursery and Reception playground, which is due to be ready after the summer holidays. The fundraising and fun events continue to help towards phase 3 (The Forest School) and the Pavilion on the school field (on Oldfield Road). This will benefit the HISN children greatly as they are currently unable to use the field because there are no toilets.
