

HPPA - An Update

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Who is HPPA?

Hampton Primary Partnership Association (HPPA) is a friendly, inclusive group of parents and carers who together make up our parents association. We are a newly formed charity who help raise money across both the infants and the junior schools (previously existing as two separate associations: HISNA and Friends of Hampton Juniors). We've brought our two parent associations together so that we can provide a more joined up approach to fundraising across both schools, and give the children and parents across the partnership the best experience as part of our school community. Our constitution will be shared on the HPP website and our charity number is 1211088.

What do HPPA do?

Our main focus is fundraising for both of the amazing schools in the partnership. We run the school discos, host parent quizzes, sell pre-loved uniform, organize the school fairs and so much more to both help raise money, but to also enhance the experience of the children in our schools and the parents and carers in our school community. We also run and help fund lots of events and experiences for the children throughout the year including visits from Father Christmas and the Easter bunny and many more! We're very busy working away to provide as much support as we can to our schools whilst making sure the children, parents and carers have lots of fun! We also provide



free uniforms for families that need it, fund school trip places, author visits & experiences for the children.

What are we fundraising for?

This year we are raising funds for a Multi Use Gaming Area (MUGA) for the Juniors and for a redevelopment of the Reception playground to include environmental spaces. We provide termly updates on money raised to date and our plans for the following term.

Who runs HPPA?

Louise Allen is our HPPA Chair and leads HPPA across both schools. Lucy Dunbar is our Treasurer. Our other Trustees are HPP's Executive Head, Helen Lockey.

All the potential roles were shared with the school community for parents and carers to put themselves forward. All individuals were interviewed prior to appointment, with the majority of roles uncontested. Current post holders will be able to put themselves forward for another year alongside any other interested parties.
