We are delighted with our end of Key Stage 2 SATs results this year. The table below shows the school's results in terms of percentage/average scores achieved:

1. The percentage of Year 6 children achieving expectations compared to the national result.
2. The average scaled score which children achieved, where 100 is the national expectation.
3. The progress measures are a type of value added measure, which means that pupils' results are compared to the actual achievements of other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment.
