School Communications

Good home/school communications are essential. Our goal is to have excellent communication procedures in school. The main ways the school communicates with parents/carers is through email via our Arbor system.

- Weekly News Notes "The Buzz" distributed on a Thursday.
- Termly Year Group Newsletters including curriculum information.
- Letters regarding events in school and general letters regarding other matters.
- School Website (<u>www.hpp.school</u>) is a valuable source for all of the above as well as term dates, school clubs, PTA information, policies and details of the Governing Body.
- **Facebook** there is a school facebook page which is constantly updated with current events.
- YouTube includes video presentations from school and can be accessed via <u>voutube.com/c/SchoolVideosHPP</u>
- **Meeting** you may speak to the class teacher at the end of the day for 5 minutes but for something longer please arrange a meeting with the class teacher via the school office giving a brief description of the content. Please do not contact the class teacher directly.
